Activity report

- 8 investigatory files opened during time period
(6 against excavators, 1 against operators, 1 against Third Party Locating Service)
- 4 investigatory file closed during time period
(1 prosecution declined, 3 warning letters)
- 1 civil action filed or still open at end of time period-Litigation matters
State ex. rel. Peterson v. G.P. Cable, Lancaster County
- 7 files placed in remediation/still in remediation-Post-Litigation matters
(monitoring compliance with Act for a period of time pursuant to Consent Decree or Court Order; or to enforce judgment)
- 0 civil case files closed after settlement or successful remediation period
- 36 investigatory files still open and under investigation/review at end of time period
- Civil penalties assessed:* \$6,000.00 (\$1,000.00 received on settlement, Lancaster County, remaining \$589.88 expected to be paid in next quarter; \$5,000.00 Judgment, Douglas County, State)
